

**Coro** is NYC's premier civic leadership training organization and a community of more than 2,500 alumni across businesses, government, schools and nonprofits shaping the city's future. Our mission is to develop NYC leaders so that all individuals, communities, and institutions participate in creating an equitable, just and engaged society. **Leadership New York (LNy)** is a 9-month, part-time leadership program for mid-career and early-executive professionals that will enhance performance by developing your personal leadership development skills, NYC knowledge, and multi-sector network.

## **Tuition**

### **What is the cost?**

Tuition for LNy is \$6,000 for over 175 hours of rigorous leadership development training, individual and small group coaching, lodging and meals at the Opening Retreat, catering on retreat days and access to Coro alumni and cross-program events. *You will be joining the most diverse and influential leadership community in NYC!*

### **Employer/Sponsor Assistance**

- This is a valuable professional leadership development opportunity and many employers help fund all or some of the tuition as a way to invest in growing the leadership of key employees. ## **Scholarships**

- Scholarships ranging from \$500-\$3,500 are available, with special consideration for applicants paying out of pocket and with the highest need relative to the request pool.
- We are committed to building cohorts that reflect the demographics of New York City and in strengthening traditionally underrepresented groups in leadership programs.

- Do not let financial concerns prevent you from applying; we are actively seeking a cohort of multiple perspectives and will work with you.
- Process: you will have the option to request scholarship assistance on the application. If you mark “yes,” you are asked to fill out the basic information of your monthly sources of income and expenses. These are accepted on the honor system – please be 100% accurate in your responses. Scholarship request information is hidden during the selection process; it is not weighted in considering you for the program.

- Please note that we are not an accredited institution; scholarships or tuition reimbursements with this requirement will not apply.

### **2019-2020 Payment Plans**

- There are three plans:
  - o Full payment of on or before September 8th, by you or your employer.
  - o Two Payments:  
50% on September 8th  
50% on December 10th
  - o Three Payments:  
50% on September 8th  
25% on December 10th  
25% on February 10th
- 100% of the tuition must be paid in full by no later than Monday, February 10th, 2020.

With the exception of an unexpected medical emergency, if you leave or are asked to withdraw from the program you (not your employer) are responsible for any remaining balance.
